Competitive Achievements: The EKU Kayaking Club went to three tournaments this year around the mid-west region. We participated at the 3rd annual University of Tennessee Whitewater Festival in September placing 5th overall in the Men's division. We also competed at the Ohio River Jam in Columbus, OH where we placed 10th overall in the Men's division and 2nd in the Women's division. Our final competition of the season was in Atlanta, Georgia where we placed 17th overall as a team. Overall our team fared well as we are only in our 3rd year of existence. Next year we would like to go to five tournaments and try to place 10th or better in every competition.

Community Service: 12 members of our club participated in the annual Lake Reba clean-up March 29 at Lake Reba Park in Richmond. We also participated in the Kayak Roll workshop with Campus Recreation in April.

Fundraising: We raised over \$500 as a club through fundraisers throughout the community. We had a bakesale at Powell Corner and held a car wash at Wal Mart in September. Next year we would like to complete more extensive fund-raising to fund our trip to Nationals in Florida.

Recruitment: Throughout the year we talked to numerous students from around campus and even a couple of students who were thinking about attending EKU. We garnered interest in two high school students who say they chose EKU because of our competitive Kayaking club.

Financial Needs: We need to purchase 3 kayaks next year to remain competitive and at least 8 new life vests and helmets. Also we would like to attend three additional tournaments at a cost of \$500 each. Ideally we would like to request \$3,000 for these items.

The Future of Kayaking: The Kayaking Club hopes to continue its success by recruiting at least four additional members each year. We would like to expand our member base and hopefully link up with other clubs around the region.
